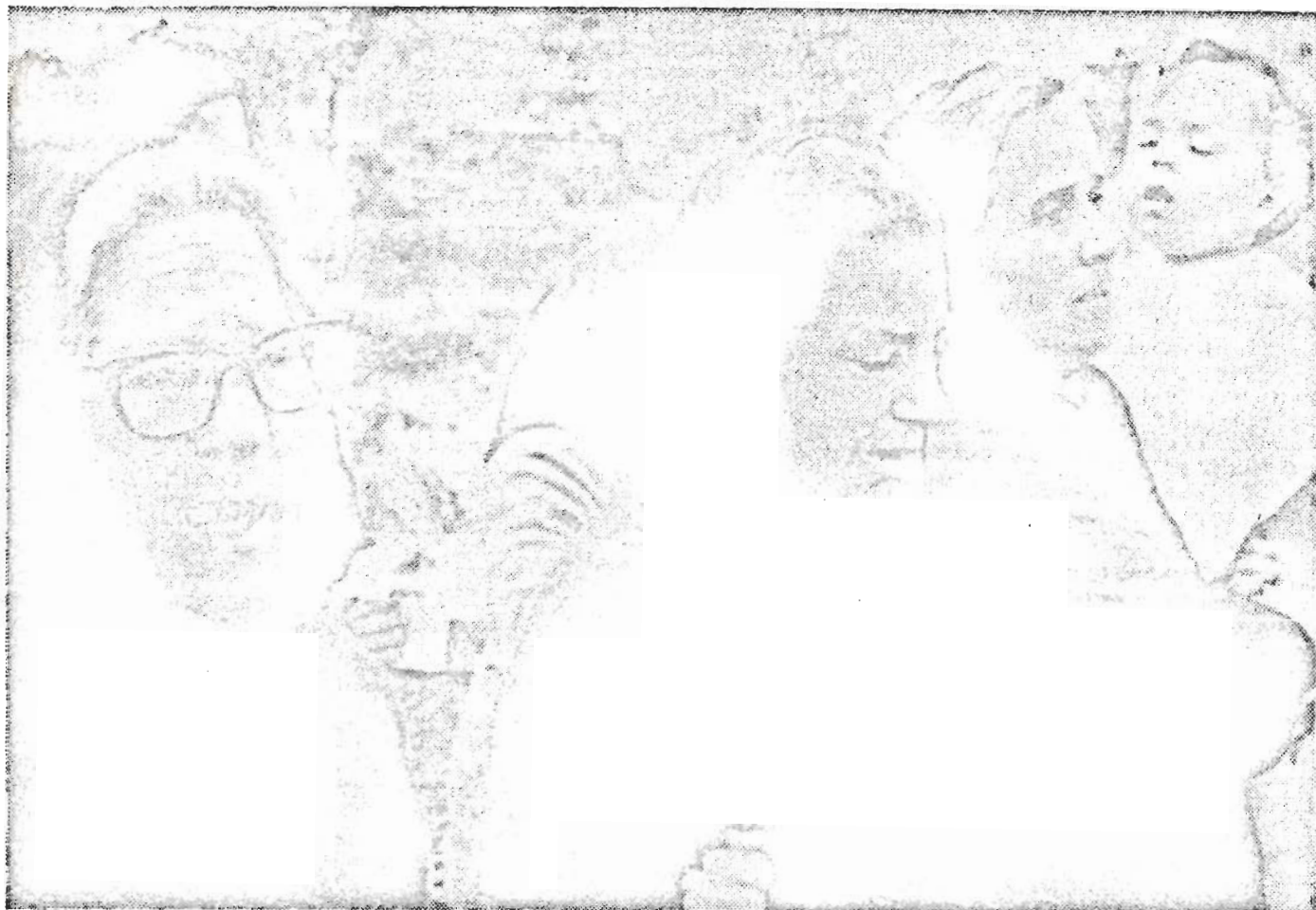

Their prayers answered as fiery lava bypasses Sant'Alfio

Lava diverted past town

SANT'ALFIO, Sicily (AP) — The flaming river of lava from Mt. Etna ran into a small hill today and flowed around it into a deserted canyon, sparing this town of 4,000 persons.

"We are safe, we are safe",

Mayor Salvatore Cozzubbo shouted happily. "Most of our land is burnt, but the town is safe."

The lava, which has slowed its pace, began a 2½-mile ride down the Cavagrande Canyon to the sea, with no town or village in its path.

"The canyon is steep and straight. The lava will just keep on going down," Cozzubbo said.

The townfolk prepared to celebrate. Sant'Alfio was spared in 1928 by another lava flow, which skirted the town and hit nearby Mafeca.

The lava has already burnt

crops and dozens of houses, causing damage estimated at over \$16 million. It has also cut across three roads in the area and destroyed five bridges.

"But probably the biggest threat to our crops are the tourists," Cozzubbo said. "They have come by the tens of thousands and trampled our fields to see the show. What the lava has spared they have ruined."

He said he had twice come into close contact with the visitors "from another dimension and the effect was one of horror. It made me want to climb a wall. That's why they don't come into direct contact with humans."

"Let's face it, the blacks and animals were happy before the whites came. Now they (the blacks and animal life) will be happy again."

He said the SIs' are upset about Vietnam. "I went to President Johnson in 1967 and told him that if he didn't stop the war, he would be ruined. I told him the dead would come back and haunt Washington."

90 Days To Clean Up

Pollution is another concern of the SIs. "They give humans just 90 more days before they begin their own PK action. Then they will turn all the waters of the earth against mankind."

"Also, I have placed PK powers on all the animals of the world. If any hunter kills an

animal unnecessarily, the power will track him down and harm him. It's like the power the ancient Egyptians put over their tombs to curse anyone who broke the seal."

He said that less than two days after he put his power into effect on behalf of the animals, a boat laden with the fur of

500 baby seals was crushed by an unexplained ice flow.

He also said that the UFO's had asked him to write to President Nixon asking for a seat in the United Nations. "In this capacity, it will be my duty to constantly bring about miracles, through SI-power, all over the world . . . constructive miracles."

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Bullets 'Jinxer' Puts Colts On List, Claims UFO Help

Ted Owens, the 51-year-old "PK man" who has a reputation for psychokinetic antics a La Evil Eye Fleagle, has placed the Colts at the top of his "Unlucky 13" loser list for next year's National Football League season.

Mr. Owens, who successfully "PK'd" the Bullets (or so he claims) after being publicly insulted by Gene Shue over national television, said that last year he hexed five teams in the NFL. But that this year he was "going to be more scientific" in his approach.

Rules Out Coincidence

"Five teams could have been coincidental. Now I'm going to stop and block half the teams in the NFL", sorcerer Ted said in an interview.

Of all the teams who have fallen under his unkindly gaze, only the Colts have given a response. "Carroll Rosenbloom wrote me twice. He's a perfect gentleman, but we couldn't come to an agreement," he said, noting his \$100,000 asking price to remove the Colts from the list.
