

Ted Owens Letters

It would probably be more accurate to describe the Ted Owens Letters as something more like Ted Owens letters to his children and documents as it is more than just 100% letters. But Ted Owens Letters to his Children is fine.

The 1975 and 1976 Letter to Millie (and scientist) and the Egyptian Report will be explained separately from the letters. But technically speaking they were sent by Lori Rodriguez as part of the letter packages of letters to children sent to Jeffrey.

But what remains from the Lori Rodriguez are the Ted Owens letter to children and what a treasure trove of information!! They dates are 1965 – 1967. They are basically Ted Owens files (letters, newspaper clipping and articles) except they pre-date the formal Ted Owens files and are combined with 50% letters of Ted Owens communicating with his children. I guess you could consider it a much more personalized version of Ted Owens files. The letters provide a different angle for looking at the personality and how Ted Owens was thinking.

Ted does reference letters his kids have sent to him but there are no letters sent from his kids to Ted Owens in the files.

There are hundreds of letters in the files and when Ted sent letters to his kids they usually included letters Ted was sending to other people, newspaper clippings, article mentioning Ted or articles Ted had written himself. That is how we get to the files being 50% letters and 50% other items.

As for the Egyptian Report and letter to Millie (and scientists), they must have been included in a rare 1977 package/letter sent to Lori. But besides that and possibly a few other exceptions, the Ted Owens letters to his children were all from 1965-1967.

I was talking with Jeff and his understanding was that no files were acquired by Lori other than what Ted Owens sent him in letters.

One thing you will notice about the letters and files is that the majority have dates on the bottom from 2025. We haven't asked Lori about the dates but we assume the information was scanned at some point and then printed out by Lori.

One topic that really did stand out in the letters was the high number of letters sent to the CIA and also to President Johnson. There are no special folders for these as they are all mixed in with the letters over the years. But I do have to say bundle #4 had the most of them compared to other bundles.

Jeff said he does have to formally ask Lori whether or not these personal letters can be made public.

File boxes already have a copy but this one looks like it was an original photo copy from a printer version. Very clear.

General Letters

Jeff received week of July 14, 2025 at 11120 Bermuda Dunes, ABQ.
Sent from Lori Rodriguez in Beaverton, Oregon.

Recorded by Lewis Barlow July 19, 2025

Received in large menial envelope.
Actual paper bundle wrapped in cellophane.

Probably 200 pages total.

Majority written in 1965 and 1966 but were a couple of letters from 1970 and 1976.

We received several different packages from Lori that contained Ted Owens letters to his children. As this was more of a general package of letters and covered several different dates, for organization purposes we will just call it general letters.

5 BUNDLES OF LETTERS AND TED OWENS FILES

Received Aug 15, 2025

Arrived in one of the five bundles of material sent to Jeff Mishlove from Lori Rodriguez arriving August 15, 2025 in Albuquerque.

Wrapped in 4 red bows (well actually red plastic twines). The fifth bundle was The May 8 1975 Special report to Mille (and scientists) did not have a red bow but was clearly a separate bundle.

Each bundles was sometimes further sperate by staples or paper clips or lose papers clearly organized by subject or dates.

Letters were most likely separated by dates. I didn't have to create special electronic folders for each bundle. The exception was obviously bundle #4 that had so many separate documents than letters such as photos section, flying saucer speak, etc.

No, the bundles were not numbered. I simply marked them bundles 1 to 5.
